Dear Friends

To continue my series of thoughts about 25 things we might do to enter into this Jubilee Year of hope 2025, this week we come to:

Suggestion No.6: Embrace sustainability. It's so easy to get caught up in the world of consumerism and give in the the throw-away culture. But, if we echo Pope Francis' encouragement in his letter *Laudato Si'*, and try to make even small eco-friendly changes in our lives - reduce waste, recycle more, assess what we really need compared to what we buy - we can focus on life's genuine pleasures and become the stewards of God's creation that we are called to be. A Jubilee year is a good time for such reflection.

Suggestion No.7: Read more of Holy Scripture. Maybe this could be just reading the Sunday Mass readings in advance (A resource such as *Magnificat* or a Sunday Missal is easily obtained.) Another idea could be to choose one of the Gospels to start with and slowly read it through over a period of time, using that as a spur to prayer and encouragement to move on to other books of the New Testament. More ambitious but a really good idea is to join a Catholic "Bible-in-a-year" reading plan or podcast to journey through Scripture from Genesis to Revelation. It's a fantastic way to see the bigger picture of God's story. Thankfully there are plenty of apps available, too, that can help you. One such, with the American Fr Mike Schmitz, can be found at the link below, or search also on Youtube:

Suggestion No.8: Practice a regular Examination of Conscience: At the end of each day, or week, write down those things that have fallen short of our call to holiness, to prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Also, write down three things you're thankful for. Gratitude can shift your perspective and bring joy even in tough moments. And at the end of the year, you can read back and reflect on everything you've been blessed with and you'll certainly see you were right to have hope. And, all the rest will have been soaked up in the grace of Reconciliation.
